## Course Description

This Key Stage Three subject covers a broad range of topics ranging from Global Citizenship through to understanding the structure of British Government and Politics across Europe. The course informs pupils how to be responsible citizens and encourages them to make informed decisions on a wide range of everyday tasks such as managing a budget and the consequences of criminal activity.

The subject supports the pupils literacy based lessons and encourages them to express their own opinion as well as balancing their opinions with that of others and creating compromise and tolerance.

Topics studied include Rights and Responsibilities, Diversity, Global Citizenship following with Crime, Financial management and the role of the media. The course is completed with developing pupil's knowledge and understanding of government at national and local level.

All elements of the topic will be assessed by written assessment half termly. There is no GCSE examination in Citizenship.

Assessment takes place half termly in each year group.
