Reading leads to success!

Extra reading beyond the classroom not only expands the students' vocabulary but it also shows them how different authors transfer their thoughts into writing, which ultimately leads to students having better writing skills.

Those who push their reading and attempt more serious literature will also gain skills in handling complex ideas.

Over the summer all prospective Year 7 students are challenged to do some holiday reading, celebrating books and the pleasure of reading them.

To enter each student needs to get a photograph of him/her being caught reading a favourite book somewhere unusual, funny or surprising. They might be posing with a book up a mountain, relaxing in a hammock or visiting somewhere exotic. Their face or head does not have to be in the photograph. The student should then attach the photograph to the *Summer Read Postcard* template (a copy will be available to download from the school website) and fill in the book review form.

All entries should be handed in to the progress tutors or to Mrs Savova in the library by Friday 15th September 2017.

The best entries in each tutor group will receive a £10.00 National Book Token as a prize.
