Dear Parents and Carers

I would like to wish all of our students, parents, carers and families a very Happy New Year. As we begin a new academic term, I would like to remind all parents of our school uniform policy. School uniform plays a valuable role in contributing to the ethos of Saint Pauls Catholic High School. Our uniform identifies students as part of our school community and instils pride in it.

Please find enclosed a copy of our uniform list (Appendix A of the Uniform Policy) and recommended footwear brochure. This outlines what are deemed to be acceptable school shoes.

➤ **Shoes**

Please note shoes must be black, must not be above the ankle and must not be trainers. Canvas shoes, plimsolls or pumps are not suitable school shoes.

➤ **Make-up and jewellery**

Students are not permitted to wear make-up, nail varnish or artificial nails in school. Jewellery is restricted to one small stud or sleeper in each ear-lobe of ears that are pierced. **Facial piercings including nose, tongues and upper ears are strictly prohibited.**

➤ **Hooded Tops**

Hooded tops are not to be worn in school.

➤ **Skirts**

The uniform policy for female students is a **black knee length skirt or tailored full length trousers** (no stretchy or tight skirts, skinny /tight trousers or jeans, track suit bottom, culottes, ski pants, leggings or jeggings).

A reminder that the use of mobile phones is prohibited during the school day.

Finally, I would like to thank our parents, carers and families for your continued support in ensuring high standards of uniform at Saint Pauls Catholic High School.

Boys

- Black School Blazer
- Black Trousers
- School jumper
- Plain White Shirt (no polo shirts or airtex sports top permitted)
- Plain Black Shoes (school shoes must not display any brand names or sports logo on the actual shoe- black trainers of any description are not permitted)
- School Tie
- Socks – plain black
- Religious dress (plain black turban)
- Jewellery and piercings - 1 small stud/sleeper in lower earlobe and wristwatch only (smart watches are not permitted)

Girls

- Knee length black skirt
- Tailored full length trousers (no skinny/tight trousers or jeans, track suit bottoms, culottes, ski pants, leggings or jeggings)
- Black School Blazer
- School Jumper
- Plain White shirt (no polo shirts, blouses or airtex sports top permitted)
- Plain Black Shoes (school shoes must not display any brand names or sports logo on the actual shoe- black trainers of any description are not permitted)
- School Tie
- Socks - plain black (over the knee socks are not permitted).
- Tights (plain black)
- Religious dress (Hijab in maroon)
- Jewellery and piercings - 1 pair of small studs/sleepers in lower earlobe and wristwatch only (smart watches are not permitted)

Schoolbags

Students should bring a bag suitable to carry their books (A4 size), writing equipment and sports kit for every lesson. All students are expected to take responsibility for their books and equipment.

All Students in Year 7 to 11 are required to wear full uniform. We have a zero tolerance policy towards incorrect uniform.
