Your son / daughter is invited on a trip to the University of Manchester Campus. This is an important aspect of raising students' aspirations and understanding of their choices beyond high school education.

The three hour visit features the following activities:

- Welcome Presentation
- Student Ambassador Question & Answer Presentation on what University is like
- Campus Tour

The objectives are for year 9 to learn about higher education in general, why people go to university and how decisions students make before leaving in year 11 impact on their future, as well as giving an insight into student life.

The campus tour includes the Student's Union, The University of Manchester Library, the oldest part of the University (The Quadrangle) and the Manchester Aquatics Centre.
