## University of Manchester Visit: Friday 22<sup>nd</sup> September

Your son / daughter is invited on a trip with Saint Paul's to visit the University of Manchester Campus. This is an important aspect of raising pupils' aspirations and understanding of their choices beyond school.

The three hour visit features the following activities:
