Dear Parent/Carer

Your child has been allocated a place to attend the "Exam Ready" GCSE French course in York on **Monday 19th March**.

We will be leaving school at 6.45 a.m. on Monday 19th March 2018. Please can you ensure that your child is at school by 6.40 a.m. as the coach will need to leave promptly at 6.45 a.m.

Any students who are late will miss the trip and will have to wait at school for the beginning of the school day.

Given that the course has been externally funded and paid for, attendance is absolutely essential. Any students not attending the course will complete the course after school with myself, as it will help to prepare students for their GCSE exams next year.

Students will need to attend in full school uniform and bring a packed lunch, as there will not be an opportunity to purchase food during the day. **Please ensure that students have sufficient water/drinks to last the day. The school rules with regards to sugary/energy drinks will still apply, and any such drinks will be confiscated.**

Please ensure that your child brings any medication they may need, e.g. inhalers, with them. We will be on a coach for two hours there and back, so if travel sick pills are needed, please ensure these are taken in the morning.
