People's History Museum - Manchester

The History department are pleased to offer Y10 History pupils an opportunity to go on an educational trip to the People's History Museum in Manchester on Tuesday, 18th December 2018. This will be second year the trip has taken place and last year was a great success.

As a part of their History GCSE, Year 10 students are studying how democracy developed in Great Britain and how the people of Britain gained power. This unit is worth 25% of their GCSE. The People's History Museum focusses on those exact themes; people and their power. Students will experience seeing artefacts and images directly relevant to their course. This is especially helpful as the idea of power changing can be challenging to visualise, so the trip will help bring the history to life. On top of this, students will take part in live action workshops called 'living history' where professional local actors come in and act out what it would have been like to be different groups of people at different times in history.

During this event, we will be taking photos of the students for publicity purposes. The photos will then be used by the school on the School Website, Twitter, Facebook, Newsletters, Adverts, displays, school literature and external press.

The pupils will be required to attend school in full school uniform as usual. Pupils will leave school at 9.00am and arrive back to school at 3.00pm. I have secured funding from Greater Manchester Higher meaning the trip will be **free of charge**. There are 75 spaces available on this trip and will operate on a first-come-first-served basis.

The permission slips must be given to your History teacher, or to Mr Buchan, **on Monday, 3rd December 2018**. Early entries will not be accepted to ensure it is fair to all students. Any slips which are not completely filled in will also not be accepted.
