Year 7 Catch-Up Funding Impact Review – 2017-2018

What is Catch-Up Premium?

Year 7 Catch-Up Premium is a type of funding additional to the main school funding. It is received from the government and from September 2016 will be allocated to those pupils whose KS2 Maths Scaled Score and / or KS2 Reading Scaled Score was 99 or below.

Schools are free to spend the catch-Up Premium as they see fit within specific parameters.

Unlike Pupil Premium, the catch-Up Premium is only awarded to students in Year 7.

Catch-Up Premium – Numeracy

All pupils identified achieved a KS2 maths scaled score of 99 or less. This cohort comprises of 18 pupils. 9 pupils were members of the school's SEN cohort.

All 18 pupils received intervention for Maths.

All pupils in Y7 have been given a Y11 GCSE target graded 9 – 1.

The grade that each pupil is currently tracking at will be a 9 – 1 grade.

Assessments will take place at the end of each half-term.

The impact of the Catch-Up Premium – Numeracy – 2017- 2018

In 2017- 2018 18 pupils were identified for intervention at the beginning of the academic year.

- 1 pupil made 1 level of progress
- 2 pupils made 2 sub levels of progress
- 5 pupils made 1 sub level of progress
- 7 pupils made no progress
- 3 pupils left school during the course of the year

Catch-Up Premium – Literacy

All pupils identified achieved a KS2 Reading Scaled Score of score of 99 or less. This cohort comprises of 14 pupils. 2 pupils were members of the school's SEN cohort.

All 14 pupils received intervention for English.

All pupils in Y7 have been given a Y11 GCSE target graded 9 – 1.

The grade that each pupil is currently tracking at will be a 9 – 1 grade.

Assessments will take place at the end of each half-term.

The impact of the Catch-Up Premium – Literacy – 2017 - 2018

In 2017– 2018 14 pupils were identified for intervention at the beginning of the academic year.

- 2 pupils made 1 level of progress
- 3 pupils made 3 sub levels of progress
- 4 pupils made 2 sub levels of progress
- 2 pupils made 1 sub level of progress
- 3 pupils made no progress.
