I would like to invite you to attend our Parents' Evening on Thursday 17th March 2022 starting at 16:30. This important evening will provide you with an opportunity to meet with teaching staff regarding the progress your child has made from September until Christmas in school and the progress.

The school introduced a new initiative last year with an easy-to-use online appointment booking system. This allows you to choose your own appointment times with teachers you will then receive an email confirming your appointments. Please note that it will work using mobile phones and I would like to thank all the parents who have contributed to the trial set up. When using any device please ensure you type the <https://stpaulscatholichigh.schoolcloud.co.uk> then simply login.

Once appointments are booked, please be aware once you are logged into the app for the evening there will be a countdown timer with the teachers. The timer will automatically end the call once your time has elapsed for both the parent and teacher with no option to staying online. If you have any further questions with a particular member of staff you can send an email using your child's email account or speak with the pastoral staff/progress leader for the year group at a later date.
