Father Owen wrítes,

Our emotions and desires can get the better of us sometimes and lead us into occasions of sin. This may manifest itself as gossip, or intimidation or in some other way. All of these ways, however, will end up eating away at us until we become no more and don't even recognise our actions, thoughts or words. They can engulf us in torrents of pride or envy and we also return to the emotions and desires because the satisfaction they give us is short lived. Enter from stage left wisdom! Wisdom is there to shine a light on our emotions and desires, to work as an indicator to be our launch away from occasions of sin. Wisdom allows us to realise that we can overcome adversaries together in relationship with God and in a prayer life that is authentic. It can sometimes be a hard road to travel. It can sometimes mean effort on our part! But the result is irrefutable. We get to live lives that are full. Full of peace and hope. Lives that can always remind us of what is important. VATICAN II REFLECTIONS: In submissions to the Synodal Process, many people expressed a desire for formation in different areas e.g. Scripture, spirituality and, specifically, the teachings of the Second Vatican Council. To meet these requests, the Department for Evangelisation is offering an introduction to the Council, together with a presentation of two of its maior Documents: Dei Verbum (on Revelation) and Lumen Gentium (on the Church). The aim is simply to give an overview of both documents, and enough insight into their content and ongoing importance to encourage people to read the texts for themselves, copies of both of which are available at the CTS or on the Vatican website. This presentation will take the form of a recorded conversation between Miss Barbara Davies (Coordinator for New Evangelisation) and Dr Stephen Yates (Senior Mission Catechist). The mp3 audio file will be available on the diocesan website from the beginning of Lent; the material will not, however, be timebound. Printable handouts will enable individual and group reflection.
