Father Owen writes,

As we start Lent, we are presented this weekend with the temptations of Jesus in Matthew's Gospel. We see how devious the devil can be and the extent to which he wishes to go to destroy the relationship Jesus has with God the Father. The same can be said of our own lives! There are times when the devil will try to tempt us into occasions of sin in order to break us away from God. These temptations can take many forms; laziness, anger, pride, lust, and the list can go on. What we find is that these temptations can become more potent and overt through Lent since this is the time when we are working on our relationship with God in an attempt to get closer to Him.

Let us find the strength of the Lord to remain on course. To stay close to the Father as much as possible. But, should it happen that we do lose our way in the desert of temptations, then let us return to God, admit our short-comings and resolve to do better next time.
