#### Father Owen writes,

In this week's scripture, we are presented with an option – do you want to see or do you want to just look? We often look at others and through this look we apply labels and disparaging comments. It's an easy rut to get into, but not so easy to get out of – just look at the world around us.... But, what God offers is not just a look, rather an opportunity to see. To see past the labels. To see past the barbed comments and our own insecurities. He offers us a chance to see that which gives life!

It is all too easy for a parish to become insular and focus on themselves, to the detriment of being truly Catholic. Truly loving and truly joy filled. Truly part of one family and to forget the tribalism of the prepandemic times. Let us forge a new outlook where no labels exist. There's no longer the 'Me, Me, Me' song chiming in our ears, but we only have the want to see people for who they truly are - 'Children of God', 'beloved of the Father', our 'brothers and sisters'!
