Father Owen writes,

In this week's Gospel we see that the disciples only recognised Jesus in the breaking of the bread – that is to say at the Eucharist. This should give us pause for thought! How do we receive the Blessed Sacrament when we approach for Holy Communion? Do we approach and receive the author of all life with dignity and reverence or are we distracted? Do we even believe that He is present there in the host and chalice body, blood, soul and divinity?

How we receive shows what we believe! Over the next few weeks we will be taking stock of how we receive the Blessed Sacrament. We will be reflecting on the reverence due and the responsibility that each of us have in being a role model to others.

Will we recognise Him in the breaking of the bread??

VOTIVE CANDLES: Father Owen has met with a company to help make our candle stands more environmentally friendly and with less risk to our churches. By the end of this month there will be new stands in churches of Saint Anthony, Sacred Heart and Saint Peter and Saint Aidan. The new systems are the most eco-friendly on the market and have been proven to cut down on waste as well as smoke and soot. It does mean, however that the suggested donation for a candle will have to rise to 50p per candle. We will monitor how it goes and if we need to adapt it then we will do so.

It begins at 9.30am with Holy Rosary, a Healing Mass at 10am followed by adoration and worship of the Most Blessed Sacrament, proclamation and reflection of scripture, Confession and healing prayers.
