Father Owen Writes:

'Now my hour has come'. On this Palm Sunday, we are given a timely reminder of what will happen now that the Lord's hour has come and it isn't easy to follow. As humans we often forget very easily that Easter cannot come without the passion and death, otherwise Easter is meaningless. We cannot have the good without the bad.

In John's Gospel we read an interaction between John the Baptiser and his disciples where John is noted as saying, 'I must decrease, so He can increase'! so let us make that our motto, that we may become more humble or begin to be humble. That through this humility we will remember that no matter how long we have been doing something or not doing something in the Church, it's not about us and what we have always done, but rather picking up a new cross and following Him into the resurrection when our parishes can rise up stronger, more faith-filled and no longer harping back to the past – but our eyes truly fixed on the new Dawn of hope, love and discipleship.
