Sports Day 2024

Dear Parent / Carer,

I am pleased to announce Sports Day this year will take place on Monday 17th June 2024. Please can you ensure your child attends school on this day wearing their correct Saint Paul's PE kit and trainers. As outlined in the school uniform policy, cycling shorts are not permitted. Please do keep up to date with the weather forecast for the day and ensure your child has a suitable black plain sports coat if needed.

For the last few years we have followed the ESAA Athletics Award Scheme that we have used in PE lessons (1 star up to Podium). However, this year pupils will build up individual points from their performance in a range of events. The points earned will also go towards their form total. Pupils and forms with the highest points will be rewarded.

Each year group will have the opportunity to compete during the following timetabled lessons –

Period 1 – Year 10

Period 2 - Year 7

Period 3 – Year 8

Period 4 – Year 9

Your child will follow their normal timetabled lessons apart from the above period and period 5. Weather dependant, during period 5, all the school will come together on the astro to watch the 50m and 100m sprint events. Pupils selected to perform during this time will have been identified through their efforts in PE lessons and will be informed prior to sports day taking place.

Please note; sports leaders will be leading most events apart from throwing events which will be led by PE staff members. As we are using the correct throwing equipment, we expect all pupils to follow all safety instructions provided and to uphold the school's behaviour policy. There will be zero tolerance for any poor / unsafe behaviour displayed whilst events are ongoing.
