1. Picture perfect!

2. Read a book by an author whose first name OR surname starts with the same letter as yours.

3. Listen to an audiobook.

4. Read a graphic novel/comic book.

5. Take an 'extreme reading' photo.

Find an unusual place/position at home and have someone take a photo of you reading a book.

6. Visit a library.

Read a book you have borrowed from a public library or from St Paul's library, showing your responsibility as you will return it when you are finished!

7. Be curious!

Read a fiction or non-fiction book about something you know nothing about. It could be set in a foreign country, about a different historical period or linked to an unusual topic.

8. Read aloud to someone.

Pets count! Or you can read to a relative or friend!

9. Create a promotion slide/trailer for a book.

Make a PPT slide or video trailer for a book you have enjoyed.

10. Do a mini-book club with a friend or friends.

Select a book to read at the same time, then discuss your thoughts with your friends. Each person needs to come up with at least 3 questions about the book.
