SOCIETY): As a society we provide help and care person to person, visiting the housebound, sick, lonely and those in care. We also provide financial help for people and families in need. Since December we have given 14 families vouchers to help with

Christmas expenses, provided a carpet for a child's bedroom and supported a lady with her move to a new property with regular visits and a new settee. We have carried out 44 visits to the sick & housebound, 12 to those in care homes, 2 hospital visits, helping at the foodbank and assisting people with shopping. We have collected for the foodbank on a regular basis and visit our local primary schools to meet the children who belong to the Mini Vinnies.

Support from parishioners helps us to carry out this vital work. There will be a Lenten retiring collection at all Masses on 12/13th April (Palm Sunday).
