I hope that your entire community, through the intercession of St Carlo Acutis, may proclaim the Gospel ever more joyfully and faithfully, attracting many young people. In communion. Solidarity with the Jewish Community

I am sure that the news of the attack in north Manchester against our Jewish brothers and sisters praying at the Heaton Park Synagogue on *Yom Kippur* brought both distress and sorrow to our hearts. Please remember the victims in your prayers, asking that the Most High might take them to Himself. *'May their memory be a blessing'* - these words of comfort are expressed by Jews to one another on the death of a loved one.

It was beautiful to hear that our Holy Father, Pope Leo XIV, was moved to remembered Manchester in his Angelus Address last Sunday, saying: 'I express my concern about the rise of antisemitic hatred in the world, as unfortunately we saw with the terrorist attack in Manchester a few days ago.' As Pope St John Paul II famously remarked in an Address to the Synagogue of Rome, 'The Jewish religion is not extrinsic to us, but in a certain way is intrinsic to our own religion. With Judaism, therefore, we have a relationship which we do not have with any other religion. [They] are our dearly beloved brothers [and sisters] and, in a certain way, it could be said that [they] are our elder brothers [and sisters].' Let's pray for peace in our world, in our country, and in our home city of Manchester.

ASDA Christmas Carol Sing


