Uniform, Hair Styles, Make-Up and Jewellery

Welcome back to the new year at St. Paul's, we hope you have had a peaceful and happy Christmas break.

We felt that at the start of this term, it would be useful to remind you all about our expectations about uniform, hair styles, make-up and jewellery as a number of students have returned after the break in violation of these regulations. Firstly, can I remind you that our rules regarding these areas can be found on the school website. In brief the following should be noted:

- Uniform should be worn appropriately at all times
- Jewellery should be limited to a small pair of stud earrings and a wristwatch. No other piercings are permitted
- Extreme hairstyles and unnaturally coloured hair are not appropriate for school
- Make up and nail varnish, including false nails and eyelashes are not permitted

Students who repeatedly fail to adhere to these rules will receive sanctions up to and including confiscation of banned items, detentions, isolation and fixed term exclusions. Year 11 students who fail to follow these rules will jeopardise their place at the end of year Prom.

Please ensure when your child comes into school they are following our simple rules regarding uniform and appearance. For those students who have uniform infringements, unnaturally coloured hair, extreme hairstyles, false nails or inappropriate piercings, a short period of grace will be allowed to rectify the problem accordingly. Form Tutors and Progress Leaders will be monitoring their students closely to ensure compliance.
